Acute rapid onset of discomfort of short duration as a result of manual handling, may

also be referred to as short term impact.

Chronic discomfort of medium to long term duration as a result of manual handling. This

may also be referred to as long term impact or long latency disease.

Ergonomics consideration of the relationship between tasks, the worker and their working

environment towards the creation of healthy workplaces.

Manager person responsible for the delivery of tasks within an organisation, often with a

team of workers reporting directly to them'

Supervisor person responsible for the day to day monitoring of performance in relation to

worker performance. Reporting into the manager of their department or

organisation.

Sustainable work work where workers are supported and protected in their working environments

on an ongoing basis, so that longer working lives can be achieved.

Work ability reflects the balance between work demands and individual (personal) resources.

For example the type of work, workload, work organisation, health, skills, values,

attitudes and motivation

Worker person performing work or work-related activities that are under the control of the

organization.
